

INTRAMURAL SPORTSMANSHIP POLICY

WARNING/EJECTION:

- 1) A warning/ejection system will be used to enforce the sportsmanship policy. Individuals will be issued a warning for unsporting behavior. A second unsportsmanlike penalty will result in an ejection. Ejections may be issued with warnings in specific situations, including fighting.

- 2) Anyone who is ejected from the game, must meet with Intramural Staff before participating in the next intramural contest
- 3) Team captains are responsible for the conduct of their players and sidelines.

SPORTSMANSHIP RATINGS

- 1) Ratings will be given to teams after each contest by intramural officials/supervisors. These ratings reflect behavior before, during, and after the contest.
 - A = 4 points. Well behaved conduct and sportsmanship to the other team and the officials
 - B = 3 points. Average sportsmanship towards officials and other team. Team members complain and officials may or may not gave out warnings.
 - C = 2 points. Below average sportsmanship towards officials and other team. Team members complain about officials and/or opposing team. Warnings may or may not have been given. Teams receiving multiple warnings or one ejection may not receive anything higher than a "C".
 - D = 1 point. Poor conduct and sportsmanship towards officials and other team. Team members constantly arguing calls with officials with abusive language.

Teams receiving three or more warnings or two ejections will not receive anything more than a "D".

F = 0 points. Unacceptable sportsmanship towards officials and other team.

Team captain is not controlling team members.

- 2) In order for your team to make the post-season, the team sportsmanship score must have an average of 3.0 or higher.
- 3) Any team receiving an F at any time during the regular season will not be allowed to play in the post-season. If you receive an F your entire team will be suspended from any intramural sport until they have meet with the intramural staff.
- 4) Teams that have an average of 2.9 or lower can come and appeal their case to play in the post-season.
