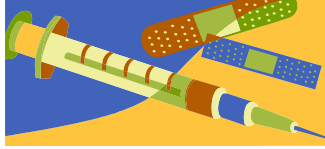


UNI Employee Wellness at the Student Health Clinic

While the Student Health Clinic primarily serves students, there are also services available to UNI faculty and staff:



Annual Flu Shots

- Staff and faculty can receive their flu shots annually on campus at the posted flu clinics, see our web site for postings of the flu clinic locations and dates each year at www.uni.edu/health



Over-the-Counter Medications

- Over-the-counter medications are available to staff and faculty. The prices of these products are competitive with the community.
- The pharmacy dispenses medications that are used most frequently by our students such as:

- Allergy treatments
- Pain and fever reducers
- Stomach upset treatments
- First aid supplies
- Cough and cold products
- Acne/skin care products
- Vitamins

Travel Counseling and Immunizations



The Student Health Clinic offers international travel consultations to advise you on destination recommended vaccinations, disease prevention, and to provide up-to-date travel information.

- We are happy to offer travel consultation to staff and faculty. There is a charge for the consultative service plus the cost of any needed vaccinations.
- We will file those charges directly with your insurance, or we can payroll deduct the cost of the consultation and vaccine, if you prefer.

Travel Immunizations

- Vaccines available at UNI Student Health Clinic:
 - Hepatitis A (series of 2 vaccinations) or a combination Hepatitis A & B
 - Hepatitis B (series of 3 vaccinations) vaccine
 - Anti-malaria medication
 - Typhoid vaccination
 - TB testing
 - Tdap (diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis)
 - Meningitis vaccine
 - Polio Adult Booster
 - Yellow Fever
